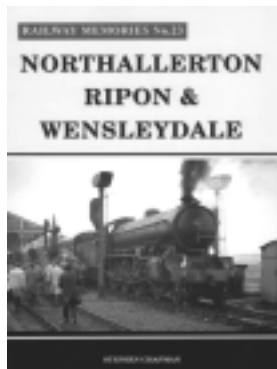

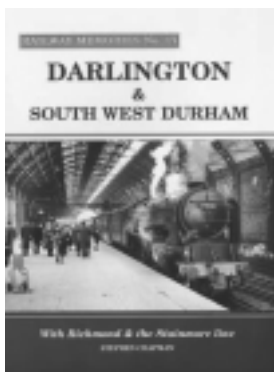


RAILWAY MEMORIES No 17

112 pages; more than 200 photographs; paperback.



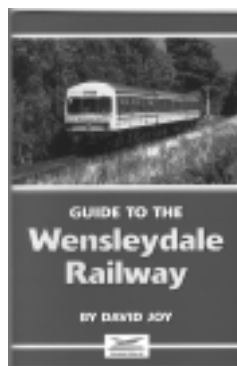
GUIDE TO THE WENSLEYDALE RAILWAY

SIR LAMIEL AND THE KING ARTHUR CLASS by Rob Adamson

Famous British Locomotives include 'Sir Lamiel' which made a guest appearance on the Wensleydale Railway in 2011.

The King Arthur Class of locomotives was developed by the London and South Western Railway and subsequently the Southern Railway. They were robust, powerful and economical, using standard components whenever possible to simplify maintenance and reduce running costs. The last of 74 locomotives in this class was withdrawn from mainline service in 1967.

This very well-illustrated book, with its authoritative text, is a 'good read'. It tells the story of the design and development of Sir Lamiel and the engineers whose work provided locomotives to meet the demanding requirements of both peacetime and the Second World War. A good gift for birthday and Christmas reading – and also for keeping on the bookshelf for future reference.

RAILWAYS OF THE NORTH YORK MOORS

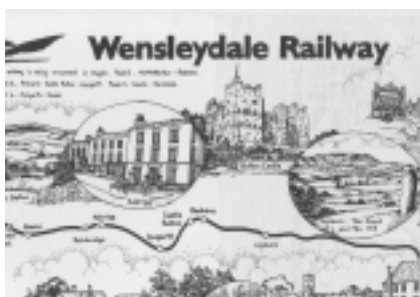

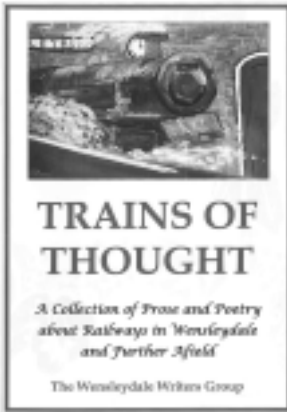

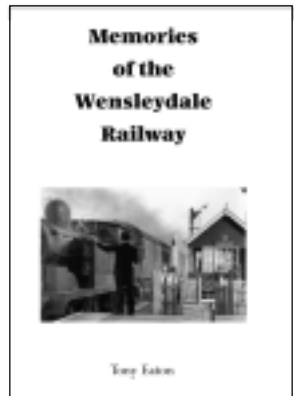
MEMORIES OF THE WENSLEYDALE RAILWAY by Tony Eaton

It must have been quite a day in 1952 when Jim Wilkinson moved his entire farm – livestock, implements and wooden buildings - by rail from Teesside to Leeming Bar.

His farming equipment and three shire horses were transported in a 19 wagon chartered train. How fortunate we are that this book includes a photograph of the horses – Jewel, Bonnie and Trixie - being led off the station platform for the last leg of their journey to the new farm.

Tony Eaton's book includes personal recollections and anecdotes by many of those who worked on the Wensleydale line in former days. Both the drama and routine – and the occasional pleasures - of working on a branch line are highlighted in this wonderfully accurate account, enhanced by a wealth of photographs, drawings and diagrams. Most of the detail is local to Northallerton and the Dale but it will resonate with anyone who has worked or travelled on the wider network. There is also a picture gallery of the signalmen and stationmasters; train crews and trackmen; porters, booking clerks and crossing keepers (and many more) whose names and faces were familiar to passengers over the years. This book was first published in 2003 and is highly recommended for its historical interest and varied illustrations; 134 pages, paperback edition.
